

Upgrade Alert: Smart sous vide app Now \$2/month!

Description

Anova, a company known for its smart sous vide cookers, is facing criticism from customers following the announcement of a subscription fee for its companion app. This app is essential for users of Anova's cooking devices as it provides cooking guides, notifications, and access to recipes. The subscription fee, priced at \$2 per month or \$10 per year, will be mandatory for new users starting August 21.

Sous vide cooking, a method where food is sealed in airtight containers and cooked in temperature-controlled water, has gained popularity in recent years. Anova, founded in 2013, offers a range of sous vide immersion circulators, with the Precision Cooker 3.0 being the latest model.

In response to the backlash, Anova's CEO Stephen Svajian explained that the subscription fees are necessary to maintain and improve the app's features.
