



US Justice Department Investigates TikTok Over Privacy Issues

Description

The US Federal Trade Commission (FTC) is looking into TikTok for privacy problems involving children. The Justice Department is also involved. TikTok's parent company is part of the investigation.

The FTC thinks TikTok might have broken privacy rules. TikTok says it is disappointed and wants to work with the FTC to fix things. TikTok does not agree with the **allegations** and prefers to find a solution together.

This **investigation** adds to TikTok's issues with data **privacy** and worries about government **involvement**. Many people are concerned about how TikTok handles data.

TikTok faces a lot of pressure in the US. Some lawmakers have tried to ban the app before. Now, this new problem makes things harder for TikTok.

The FTC is focused on whether TikTok followed the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA). This law helps protect kids' privacy online.

TikTok says it has been trying to follow the rules. The company wants to find a way to solve the problem without going to court.
