

Wicked Set to Soar with \$165M Global Box Office Debut

Description

UPDATED: Universal's *Wicked* is enjoying a remarkable global debut, now projected to earn **\$165M** through Sunday. As anticipated, the majority of revenue is coming from North America, with the expected breakdown being **\$117M** from domestic markets and **\$48M** from international ticket sales.

On a global scale, *Wicked* is set to achieve the highest opening weekend for a film adapted from a Broadway show, surpassing *Les Miserables*'s **\$103M** and ranking as the 6th largest opening weekend of 2024. Additionally, it will secure the 4th biggest theatrical debut for a musical, outpacing *The Little Mermaid*, which earned **\$163.6M**.

Internationally, *Wicked* is performing within the expected range. Currently released in only 61 markets, representing 65% of its overseas potential, major territories such as France, China, Germany, and Japan have yet to unveil this highly anticipated film directed by Jon M. Chu.

Notably, in comparable markets, *Wicked* is on track for the highest opening for a Broadway adaptation, outshining *Les Miserables*. The \$48M international estimate marks it as the 6th highest opening for a musical globally, ahead of *Mamma Mia: Here We Go Again* (\$43M).

The **UK** leads the offshore markets, with box office projections exceeding \$15M through Sunday. Launching on Friday, it amassed an impressive \$4.9M, claiming the top position with a substantial 63% market share. This opening marks Universal's most substantial debut since *No Time To Die* in 2021.

In addition, **Australia** has welcomed *Wicked* with open arms, while **Mexico** reports record-breaking earnings as well. As the overseas rollout of *Gladiator II* continues alongside *Wicked*, the overall box office landscape remains vibrant.
