# William and Harry, Princes, to attend Diana's tribute event independently.

## Description

Prince William and Prince Harry will each have a role in an event honoring their mother, \*Diana, Princess of Wales\*. William is expected to give a speech at the \*Diana Legacy Awards\* in London, marking the charity's 25th anniversary. Following William's departure, a video message from Harry will be aired. The Diana Legacy Awards are held biennially and notably recognize young leaders. Established after Diana's tragically died in a car crash, William is set to meet the award winners post the event. Harry's contribution is virtual due to residing in the United States after his split from the working royals. Their relationship has frayed since Harry's controversial memoir release, which suggested William was difficult and rude.
